

Decree no. 79/2020 of the Rector of the Medical University of Gdańsk dated 7th September 2020 concerning the risk minimisation of SARS-CoV-2 transmission in dormitories at the Medical University of Gdańsk

Pursuant to art. 23 sect. 1, sect. 2 p. 2, art. 50 sect. 1, art. 51 sect. 1 of the Higher Education and Science Act of Law dated 20th July 2018 (Journal of Laws 2020, it. 85) and § 23 sect. 1 and sect. 2, §28 sect. 5 p. 1 of the MUG's Statute (App. no. 1 to the Resolution no. 18/2020 of the MUG's Senate) and §1 of the Minister of Health Ordinance concerning the announcement of the state of epidemic in the Republic of Poland (Journal of Laws 2020, it. 491, as amended)

- amid the threat of contracting COVID-19 by students, doctoral students and employees accommodated in the dormitories at the Medical University of Gdańsk for whom the MUG is the authority:

I hereby decree:

§1

In order to minimise the risk of SARS-CoV-2 transmission by reducing contact in dormitories at the MUG a strict ban of non-residents stay is introduced. It is also advised to reduce the amount of guests and organisation of social gatherings in rooms in the dormitories or in the dormitories area.

§2

- 1. Taking into account effective protection against SARS-CoV-2 it is advised to:
 - 1) keep at least1,5 meters distance between persons,
 - 2) avoid crowded places,
 - 3) cover nose and mouth and wear gloves in public places,
 - 4) wash hands frequently and disinfect them with alcohol solutions,
 - 5) avoid touching your face, especially eyes, mouth and nose area,
 - 6) avoid handshake greeting,
 - 7) using the safe way to sneeze or cough,
 - 8) care about your environment by regular disinfection of contact surfaces or mutual spaces in the dormitory,
 - 9) have your temperature taken at the entrance of the dormitory.
- 2. Any violation of those rules shall result in consequences, termination of the agreement included.

§3

- 1. In the case of observing COVID-19 symptoms the student then shall contact a medical doctor or the proper medical entity for infectious diseases via phone

Shall any resident of the dormitory fell sick they shall inform the dormitory administration.
