

Decree no. 16/2022

of the Rector of the Medical University of Gdańsk dated 25 February 2022

concerning the organisation of the academic year 2022/2023

Pursuant to art. 23 sect. 1 and sect. 2 p. 2 of the *Higher Education and Science Act of Law* dated 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws 2021, it. 478), par. 23 sect. 1 and sect. 2 p. 2, par. 28 sect. 5 and par. 70 sec. 6 of the MUG Statute dated 3 June 2019 (namely, App. No. 1 to the Resolution 20/2021 of the MUG Senate dated 26 April 2021) in accordance with par. 4 of the *Rules of Study* that constitutes App. No. 1 to the Resolution 25/2021 of the MUG Senate dated 26 April 2021 concerning the introduction of the *Rules of Study*

it is now decreed, as follows:

§ 1

At the Medical University of Gdańsk the academic year 2022/2023 starts from 1 October 2022 and lasts to 30 September 2023 according to the following semester division:

Note:

- *Academic classes in the summer semester for Pharmaceutical and cosmetic manufacturing and the 6th year of Medical studies [Polish and English Division] may last till 30 June 2023.
- On 7 October 2022 rector's hours are planned due to the new academic year inauguration.
- Orientation Week for 1st year students of English Division lasts from 26 September 2022 to 30 September 2022.
- Terms of the examination session do not pertain to the First Doctoral School and students who do their courses in the block system, and are obliged to take their examinations continously (examinations are held immediately upon the completion of the relevant course block).
- During the academic year vocational practice in accordance with the study programme is obligatory.
- Examination session dates, semester and holiday breaks do not pertain to 6th year Master of Pharmacy students.

Part-time students have no semester break, or any strictly defined examination session. The examinations are held directly upon completion of the specific course. The retake examination session must end by 17 September 2023.
